## Farming on the Greenbelt?

### Farming Power

#### Cost-share for Energy Innovation in the Greenbelt

Funding is available now for 2013 energy retrofit projects in the Greenbelt!

- Eligible BMPs include: lighting upgrades, milk plate coolers, cooling compressors, free cooling systems and heating upgrades.
- Cost-share ranges from 30% to 50%, with up to \$5,000 available within each BMP category. Each farm business can access up to \$10,000 total.
- Simple application process, made downloadable online, [here](#) [1].
- The eligible invoice date is retroactive to April 1, 2013, so if you've already completed a project this year you may be able to get money back.
- Project funding can be combined with other environmental cost-share provided through local conservation authorities , Ducks Unlimited and Growing Forward 2
